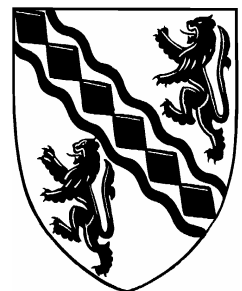

The Lee Medical Practice

2 day physiotherapy course programme

This is a two day workshop which covers assessment, setting aims and goals (G.A.S.), outcome measures and treatment based on the Lee Method. Some theory is discussed but it is mainly practical in nature and involves delegate participation. Michele Lee and Sue Yoxall will share the lecturing and supervision of practical sessions over the two days. Maximum number is 14 participants. Course fees cover lunch, refreshments and comprehensive handouts.

Aims of the course:

- For each delegate to have an understanding of the definition of Dyspraxia and related conditions
- To understand the relevance of co-morbidity with other conditions
- Know how to identify the condition
- Be able to carry out an assessment
- Be able to set aims and goals for the child
- Have some knowledge of standardised tests available
- Have an understanding of how to use the Goal Attainment Scale and Outcome Measures
- Consider current research in Britain and the effectiveness of treatment
- Have some knowledge to the different forms of treatment
- Treatment ideas both for individual and group work
- Understanding how to plan treatment sessions
- Have some knowledge of alternative therapies
- Have some understanding of other aspects of the child's life such as with bullying, self esteem and social skills
